### THE DAY BEFORE

# **CLEAR LIQUIDS ONLY!!!**

#### **APPROVED LIQUIDS TO DRINK:**

- Coffee or Tea (no creamer or milk)
- Fruit juices apple, white grape, pineapple (no pulp)
- Jell-O, Popsicles no red or purple
- Water
- Broth (chicken, beef, vegetable)
- Clear soda (Sprite, Ginger Ale, 7-up)
- Sport drinks no red or purple

#### DO NOT:

- Eat anything
- Drink anything **RED OR PURPLE**
- Drink alcohol
- Take any other laxatives while taking CLENPIQ

<u>At 5pm the day before your appointment</u> you will start by taking the 1<sup>st</sup> dose of Clenpiq followed by 40oz of clear liquids (water, juice, Powerade, Gatorade etc.).

### THE DAY OF COLONOSCOPY:

<u>5 hours before your appointment</u> you will take the 2<sup>nd</sup> dose of Clenpiq followed by 40oz of clear liquids (water, juice, Powerade, Gatorade, etc.).

- YOU MUST FINISH DRINKING AND HAVE NOTHING ELSE 2 HOURS BEFORE YOUR APPOINTMENT
- YOU MUST HAVE SOMEONE TO DRIVE YOU HOME

### Take Your Regular Medications the Morning of Your Procedure:

Most medications are safe to take 1 hour before starting the 2<sup>nd</sup> dose of CLENPIQ. Insulin and other diabetes medication should NOT be taken unless specifically instructed to do so. Blood thinners (ex: aspirin, Eliquis, Xarelto, Plavix, Brilinta, Coumadin) should NOT be taken.
