Medical Oncology

Medical oncologists are specially trained physicians with expertise caring for cancer patients as well as patients with blood disorders such as leukemia, lymphoma, and anemia. With chemotherapy and immunotherapy medicines, as well as early diagnosis and treatment, medical oncologists are able to fight cancer cells and save lives.

Chemotherapy and Infusion Services

Chemotherapy, also known as chemo, is the use of drugs or other chemical substances to treat cancer. It is one of many cancer treatment options at Lane Cancer Center and is often used in conjunction with cancer surgery or radiation therapy.

The way chemotherapy is given depends on the drugs used. Most often, chemo is injected intravenously and is also called IV therapy.

Other options for chemotherapy include pills or liquids that are taken by mouth, or injected into a muscle or fatty tissue. The length of chemo treatment depends on the cancer type, which drugs are used and how a patient responds to the treatment.


