Y EXPANSION

4-story Patient Tower at Half-Way Point

A year after demolition began, construction of the 4-story patient tower is at the half-way point. Exterior work is nearing completion, and the focus has shifted to the interior. Weather permitting, the new patient tower will open December 2024. More details and time lapse videos can be found on the Lane website at LaneRMC.org.

Construction Work Completed:

- New sewer line
- Concrete slab
- Two stairwells and two elevator shafts
- Firewall between existing building and new construction
- Structural steel work
- Concrete floors
- Exterior wall studs and sheathing
- Lightweight concrete roof with rubber matting
- Three A/C chillers
- Fireproofing spray


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

- 4 operating suites equipped with advanced technology
- 15 private pre- & postsurgery patient rooms

Weight Loss Surgery With a Gastric Sleeve Annette Ponthier's Patient Story

"Everything is great!" These are the words of Annette Ponthier a year after her weight loss surgery. Annette was the very first patient to have the gastric sleeve procedure at Lane, and her experience could not have been better with Dr. Frank Sanfiel and the staff at the Lane Surgery Group.

Before Annette's gastric sleeve surgery, everything felt like a chore. "I would get winded just by walking. I'd constantly need to rest. I needed to use a shoehorn. I was taking medicine for a number of health conditions," remembers Annette.

After her gastric sleeve procedure, none of that is needed. Annette enjoys being active and exercising. She is off all of her medications, and there's not a shoehorn in sight. So far she has lost more than 85 lbs.

"I love how I feel and that I can get down on the floor and play with my grandkids. It's been great, but I still have a way to go to reach my goal weight," says Annette.



OB/GYN and Labor & Delivery Services Courtney Spears' Patient Story

When Courtney Spears and her husband, Everett, were expecting their first child, Emanie, seven years ago, she began seeing Dr. Joshua Best at Lane OB/GYN. Living in Baker, Baby Lane (the labor and delivery unit at Lane), along with their expert staff of OB/GYNs, nurses, ultrasound techs, and more was a perfect option for the Spears family.

In 2020, Courtney and Everett became parents again to Ethan and Curtis. "Seeing two babies on the screen during the ultrasound was a surprise. We were shocked but so happy," remembers Courtney. Fast forward to 2021 and Courtney is looking at a familiar screen, this time with twins Emory and Cassidy. Once again, the pregnancy went very well under Dr. Best's care.

After having five beautiful, healthy, and happy babies,
Courtney scheduled a tubal ligation with Dr. Best. "Before the
procedure, I had to take a pregnancy test, and it was positive."
With a positive pregnancy test, Courtney's next stop was to see Emily,
her ultrasound technician over the past few years. Courtney recalled,
"During the ultrasound, Emily just stared at me. The shock on her face
said it all, and she just shook her head 'Yes." Courtney was pregnant with
her third set of twins in three years, Eva and Camryn.

Outpatient Therapy

Kim Armstead's Patient Story

When Kim Armstead tore her rotator cuff, finding a physical therapist at Lane Outpatient Therapy was at the top of a very short list. "Living in Ethel and working at Lane made attending physical therapy there an easy choice," says Kim. "Not only was it a convenient option, but my husband, Dexter, and daughter, Autumn, also previously rehabbed with the physical therapists at Lane."

While Kim can't pinpoint exactly what caused her rotator cuff tear, she underwent surgery shortly after the diagnosis. "The doctors debrided the rotator cuff and also cleaned out some arthritis while they were in there. I started physical therapy a few days later," remembers Kim.

Physical therapy is an essential part of the recovery process following a rotator cuff tear. This treatment provides several advantages to patients in their recovery and regaining maximum shoulder function, regardless of the extent of the tear.

A few of the benefits that physical therapy offered to get Kim back in action after her surgery included pain reduction, improved range of motion, strengthening muscles, functional training, and individualized treatment.



Sessions are one-on-one with experienced therapists to reach goals more quickly.

"The interaction was great. I saw Kacey, Scott, and Kim. It was truly personalized care, and they were there for me the entire time."

Diabetic Wound Care Lyle Brown's Patient Story

Lyle Brown's experience at Lane Wound Care began several years ago, driven by a complex medical history marked by diabetesrelated complications. "It's like a family there. You're not just a patient; you're part of their family," Lyle said, reflecting on the warm atmosphere that greeted him. From the clerical staff to the medical professionals, he felt a sense of belonging and caring.

Over the years, Lyle faced a series of challenges, including the amputation of two toes on his left foot due to his diabetes. He vividly recalled the turning point when a home health nurse recommended that he see Dr. Trahan at Lane Wound Care as his condition was deteriorating and needed an effective solution for a non-healing wound.

Lyle's story took an unexpected turn when he developed Charcot syndrome, a condition causing bones in his foot to collapse, and it was decided that amputation of his right foot was the best course of action.

Through a combination of wound care and hyperbaric oxygen therapy, Lyle found relief and healing.



The surgery entails a one-night inpatient hospital stay, but most people can return to work in as little as a week after the procedure.

HERO Club Donation

For parents who lose a child at birth, parting with a stillborn baby is the first step in a long and difficult grieving process, one that can take a lifetime to come to terms with. A new device called Caring Cradle is now available at Lane and aims to make that journey a little easier.

The cooling device preserves a stillborn baby's body in a bassinet or crib so that he or she can remain in a hospital room, extending the time a family has to bond with, and grieve over, their baby before saying their final goodbyes.

Dawn Fuller, director of Lane's Labor & Delivery unit says, "About 24,000 babies are delivered stillborn in the United States every year. Losing a newborn brings on a particularly complex grief, because it's so unexpected and so drastic. Bidding a proper goodbye is crucial to a healthy grieving process. We are so grateful to be able to offer this service to our community."



The Lane Foundation and the hospital's HERO Club members donated funds to purchase the Caring Cradle. The value of this donation is \$8,000, and the Caring Cradle will help improve the care of families experiencing neonatal loss.
