THE DAY BEFORE

CLEAR LIQUIDS ONLY!!!

APPROVED LIQUIDS TO DRINK:

- Coffee or Tea (no creamer or milk)
- Fruit juices apple, white grape, pineapple (no pulp)
- Jell-O, Popsicles no red or purple
- Water
- Broth (chicken, beef, vegetable)
- Clear soda (Sprite, Ginger Ale, 7-up)
- Sport drinks no red or purple

DO NOT:

- Eat anything
- Drink anything **RED OR PURPLE**
- Drink alcohol
- Take any other laxatives while taking SUTAB

<u>At 5pm the day before your appointment</u> you will start taking the 1st dose of SUTAB. Take one tablet every 2-3 minutes until you have taken the first 12. You will need to drink 48oz of water (approximately 3, 16.9oz bottles) over 3 hours.

THE DAY OF COLONOSCOPY

<u>5 hours before your appointment</u> you will start the 2nd dose of SUTAB. Take one Tablet every 2-3 minutes until you have taken the last 12 tablets. You will need to drink 48oz of water (approximately 3, 16.9oz bottles) over 3 hours.

- YOU MUST FINISH DRINKING AND HAVE NOTHING ELSE 2 HOURS BEFORE YOUR APPOINTMENT
- YOU MUST HAVE SOMEONE TO DRIVE YOU HOME

Take Your Regular Medications the Morning of Your Procedure:

Most medications are safe to take 1 hour before starting the 2nd dose of SUTAB. Insulin and other diabetes medication should NOT be taken unless specifically instructed to do so. Blood thinners (ex: aspirin, Eliquis, Xarelto, Plavix, Brilinta, Coumadin) should NOT be taken.

Stop taking,,,	days before your procedure.
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
